WHY TAKE ATTENDANCE?

At Freed-Hardeman University, all undergraduate courses are required to take attendance. Students are required to attend at least 75% of all courses in order to receive academic credit. Holly Rowsey and the team at Freed-Hardeman believe that interaction with instructors is at the heart of the student experience, which can only be achieved by attending class regularly.

BENEFITS OF QWICKLY ATTENDANCE

Freed-Hardeman University has experienced a number of benefits since implementing Qwickly Attendance, including:

- Increased efficiency by automating many of the tasks associated with taking attendance
- Improved accuracy of attendance records.
- Enhanced student engagement by giving students real-time feedback on their attendance.
- Increased retention by identifying students who are at risk of dropping out and providing them with the support they need to succeed.



ATTENDANCE TAKING FEATURES

CHECK OUT

Instructors at Freed-Hardeman University use Qwickly Attendance's check-out feature to ensure students stay for the duration of class and special events. If a student misses either a check-in or check-out time, they are marked as absent.


COURSE MERGING

Students in Freed-Hardeman's music department are required to attend a certain number of performances throughout the semester. Instructors use Qwickly Attendance's course merging feature to merge all performances into one session, cutting down on time spent manually counting how many performances were attended each semester.

CUSTOM STATUSES

Freed-Hardeman has established system-wide statuses, such as "Present, "Absent," and "Excused." However, the university also allows instructors to create their own course statuses, such as "Tardy," to align with their individual course policies. For example, some instructors may have a policy of allowing students to be tardy five times before it counts as an absence, while others may have a policy of allowing only two tardies. The screen below demonstrates what a present, absent, and excused status looks like in an attendance record. The attendance record below shows a green check for Present, a red x for Absent, and a blue circle with a line for Excused.


Qwickly Attendance provides the flexibility to accommodate individual instructor's policies, while making it easy for these unique statuses to be tracked in a universal system, allowing high-level administrators to confirm students are attending class 75% of the time, based on the university-wide policy.





ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS

Freed-Hardeman University uses the Absence Notifications feature to ensure students attend 75% of their classes. Qwickly Attendance can send warning and final notifications to students who are approaching the 25% absence limit. Administrators can also use Qwickly Attendance to run reports, allowing them to see which students need to be dropped from a class due to excessive absences.



SCHEDULE SESSIONS

Qwickly Attendance makes it easy for Freed-Hardeman instructors to pre-plan class sessions. Administrators can upload a .CSV file with information on the start/end dates and the days of the week it meets. Qwickly Attendance is able to digest the data uploaded and automatically schedule attendance sessions for the classes detailed in the file upload.

Freed-Hardeman has one class that holds 1,300 students, the entire undergraduate student population. For students in the nursing program or student-athletes who have clinicals/rotations or games on certain days, instructors can pre-exempt them from class using scheduled sessions, so applicable students are not counted as absent.

CONCLUSION
